Dear Chairman Conway and Members of the Committee:

The Maryland League of Conservation Voters is pleased to join with other conservation groups in urging your support of Senate Bill 156, “Environment - Recycling - Apartment Buildings and Condominiums.”

SB 156 will require owners or managers of apartment buildings or condominiums that contain ten or more units to provide recycling for residents on or before October 1, 2014.

Combined with the successes of Maryland’s recycling program, the current 41.1% recycling rate in the state can only be improved by SB 156. Additionally, the Maryland Climate Commission determined that increasing recycling is among the most cost efficient ways to reduce Maryland’s global warming pollution.
